What is my Personal Data?

Personal data is information that allows for your identification; for example your name, address, telephone number or email address.

How is my Personal Data managed?

We collect personal information about you when you make an enquiry, make an appointment, visit the House of Prayer or place an order via our website.

Will my Personal Data be shared?

We will never share your personal data with a third party for marketing purposes. If you visit the House of Prayer, your details will be held on our calendar and office Email. Your email may be securely held by Mailchimp and, if appropriate by our Accountants.

We will hold your details relating email, address or telephone numbers for the purpose of making or confirming appointments for booking quiet days or courses, processing book orders, answering letters or responding to queries.

There are four circumstances to the above permitted by law where personal data can be disclosed without the consent of the data subject:

- Where BFAT is legally compelled to do so
- Where there is a duty to the public to disclose
- Where disclosure is required to protect our interest
- Where disclosure is made at your request or with your consent
